### Celebrations of Life (Memorial Service)

When a beloved one dies, whether it be a sudden unexpected death, or a lengthy illness that leads to death, the grief and sorrow that accompany can be so difficult. The United Church of Christ in North Hampton desires to be a community in which the lives of the saints might be honored and released to the loving care of God.

When a loved one dies, the pastor is available to families in grief. He is honored to meet with families to pray and plan Memorial Services, Celebrations of Life, and Graveside Committal Ceremonies. Most often, funeral homes will contact the church and communicate on behalf of a family who has lost a loved one about the details of a service or ceremony. The pastor then contacts the family to meet, pray, and plan.

#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### Do I have to be a member of North Hampton UCC to hold my loved one's service here?

You do <u>not</u> need to be a member to have your celebration of life at UCC North Hampton.

#### What is needed to prepare for a celebration of life?

The Pastor will arrange a meeting to sit with you to discuss the various questions about your desires for a service, including date, number of people expected, scripture preferences, hymn preferences, special music, readers, bulletin information, internment, etc.

#### What is the cost to hold a celebration of life at North Hampton UCC?

There is a fee for the use of the sanctuary for non members (\$200).

Additional honorariums are required for the musician (\$200), the Pastor (\$300) and a cleaning fee (\$50)

#### Can I hold a bereavement reception after the service?

Our vestry is available for use after a memorial service, which does include use of the kitchen and our tables and chairs. There are fees associated with using the vestry for non-members.
